WIN (What I Need) time, which is our way of meeting the specific academic
needs of each student. Our classroom teachers and support staff meet to review
student data and then form groups based off of the skills for which students need
additional support in. Each day for 20-30 minutes, students work in a group with a grade
level teacher or other support staff to increase in that skill. Over the course of the year,
staff will meet many times to review progress and form new skill-based groups. This is a

great way for us to help students catch up in areas where they struggle, in addition to teaching them the grade level content.

We had our first assembly guests during our Friday Focus assembly today! The Port Angeles Symphony sponsors the Adventures in Music program which brings different musical presentations to our assemblies throughout the year. 

### SPEECH & LANGUAGE SCREENER


Dear Parent,

Our school will be conducting a speech/language screener on all kindergarten students. This screening is used to identify children who may need a more comprehensive evaluation or if they would benefit from RTI services. Response To Intervention (RTI) is a service that the speech department can offer children that need just an extra bit of support with:

- Articulation (speech sound production)
- Expressive Language
- Receptive Language
- Pragmatic Language (social language)
- Fluency






