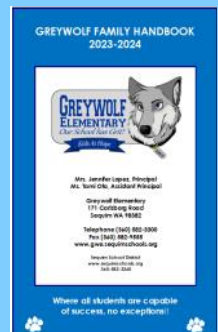


FAMILY HANDBOOK

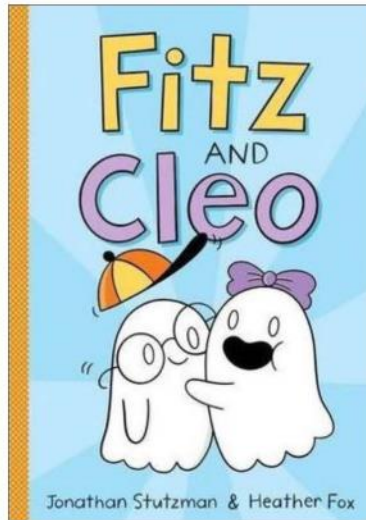

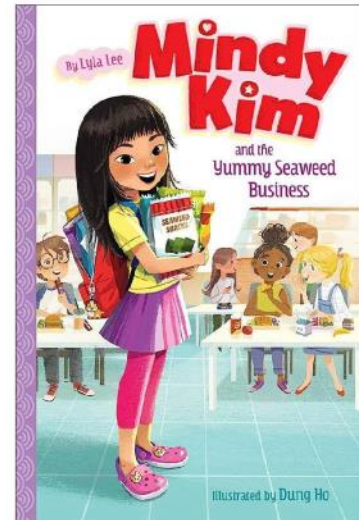
